VILLAGE BOARD APPROVES STOP SIGN REMOVAL

On Thursday, March 18, 2021 the Village of Tilton Board of Trustees approved for the Public Works Department to remove the stop signs at the intersection of 14th street and 1st Ave. This would take the intersection from a 4-way stop to a 2-way stop. Traffic traveling east and west on 14th street will no longer have to make a stop. However, if you are coming from 1st Ave then you will be required to stop.

Tilton Police made a statement earlier this week to the residents urging them to use caution and to watch their speed. Officers will be out enforcing speed limits, especially in the residential neighborhoods.
